

Oscar Wilde: *the remarkable rocket*



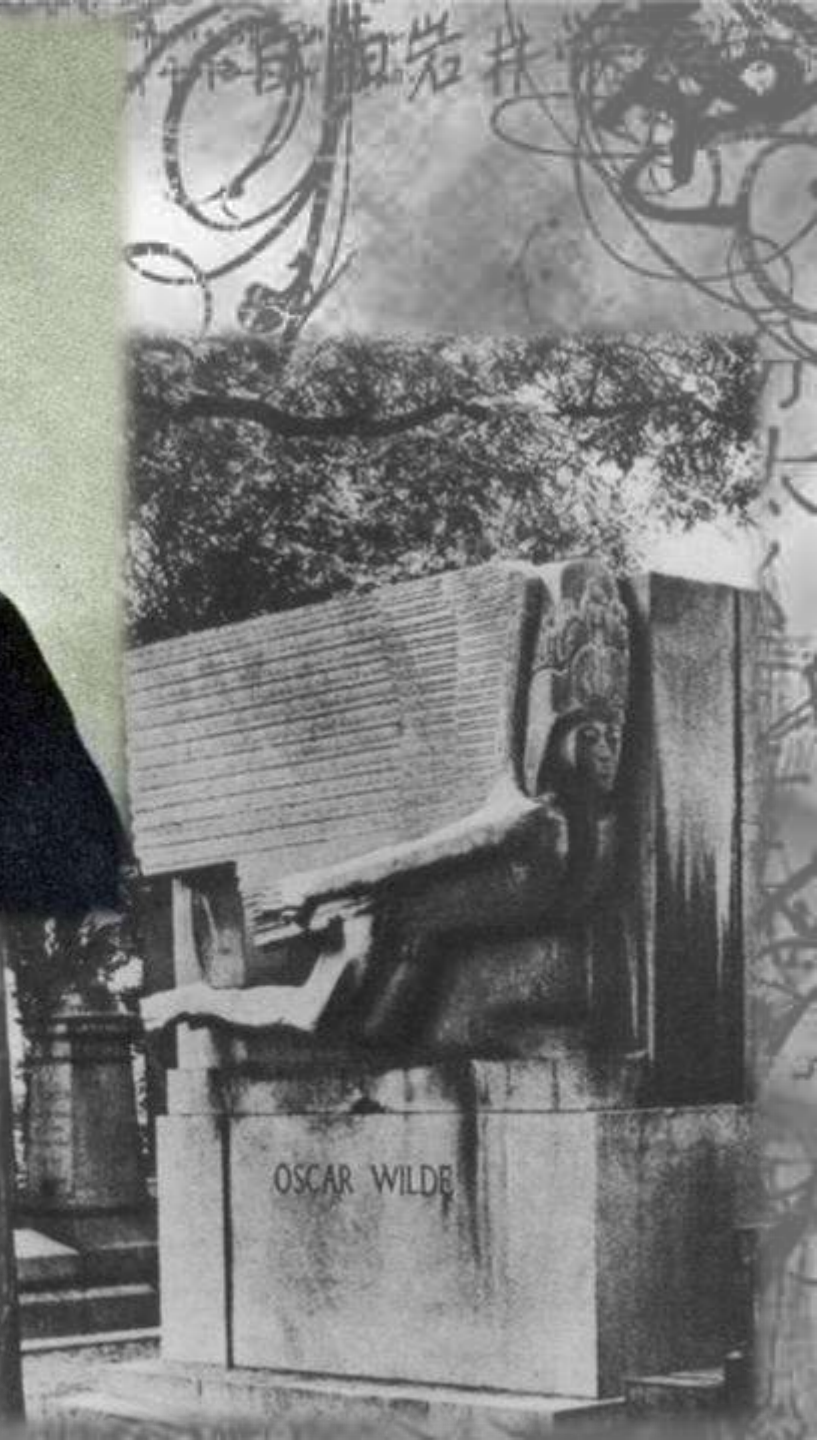
- ***Oscar Wilde was born on October 16, 1854.***

- ***Father, William Wilde was leading in Ireland doctor.***

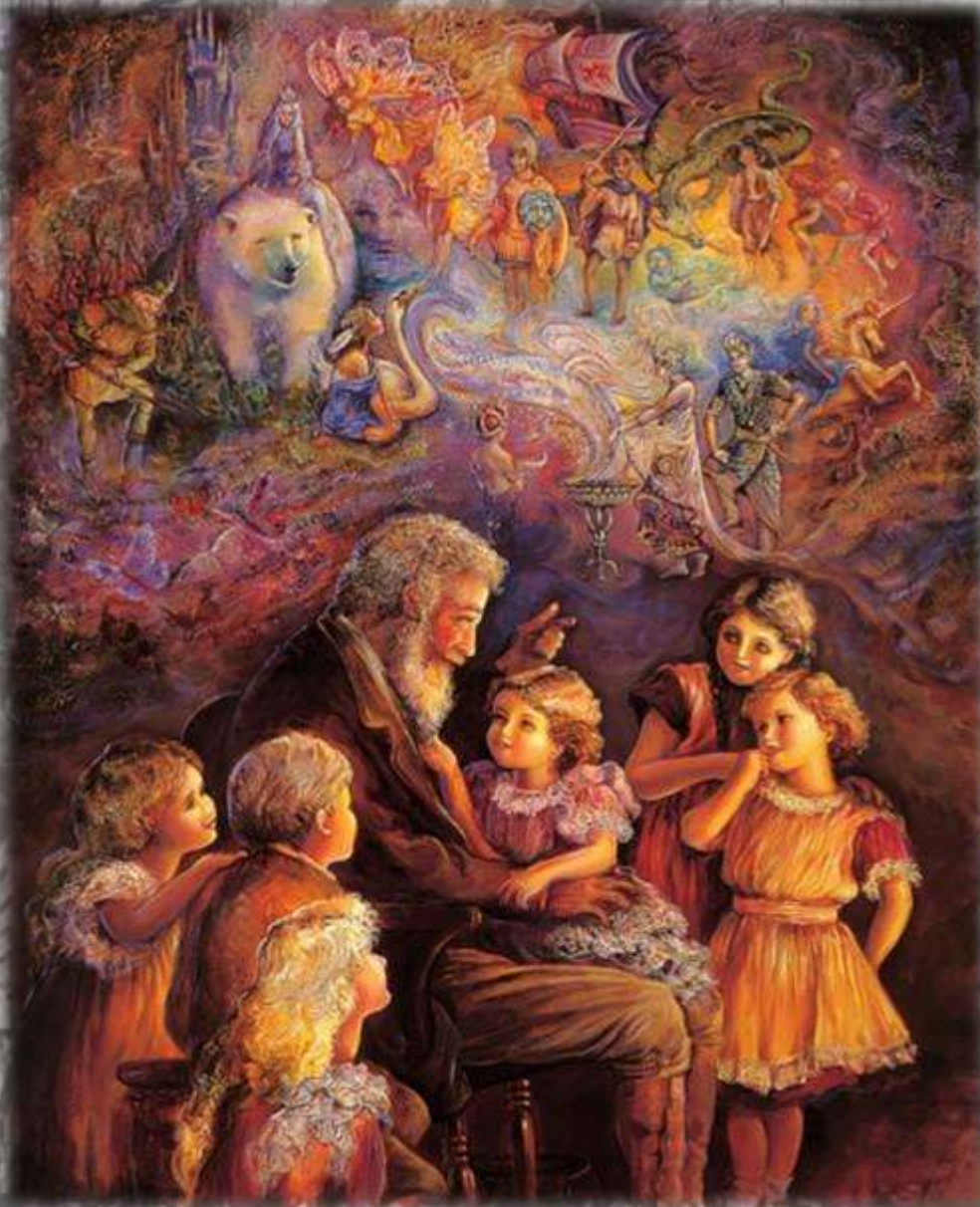
