

Preposition

The cat is under the table





Use "in" when:


We use in to show that something is

enclosed or <u>surrounded</u>.



The boys are boxing in the ring.

The ball is in the box.



We also use in to show towns, states, countries and continents.

I live in Saint -**Petersburg**






Use "on" when:

We use on to show position on a

horizontal/vertical surface.




The cups are on the table

Under

It means at a lower level. (Something is above it).



The blue animal is <u>under</u> the table.

In front of


(Noun 1) +to be+ In front of (noun 2)

Behind

It means at the back (part) of something




The striped cat is behind the tree.



Between
